My Father

With deep grief and with great hope I am bringing the news of my father who passed away and entered into Glory on 22nd February 2008. God gave me the privilege to minister to him during the last 2 weeks of his life and be at his bedside while he breathed his last. I feel the loss of him passing away and I will miss him for a long time. I will covet your prayers for me and our whole family.

2008

The year 2008 seems to be a year of restoration and a great ingathering of souls. The year started for me with a lot of travelling and ministry. It will be hard for you to believe that I travelled through 12 states of India and Nepal within 1 month from January 1st to February 1st. I have travelled almost 14,000 miles some in planes and most of them in trains, buses and jeeps. I went to the state of Assam which is bordering China and had 3 days of meetings with our Pastors and Bible School Students. This state is not at all safe because of a lot of terrorism going on.

New Orphanages in West Bengal

After Assam I travelled to West Bengal to the city of Malda where we have established 2 orphanages, 1 for boys and the other for girls. I have purchased 1.5 acres of land to build the buildings for the orphanages and the headquarters of our ministry in that state. By faith I laid the foundation stone to begin the building programme. We need \$50,000 to build all those buildings. The following week I travelled to Gujarat

to visit our Bible School in Vapi and our orphanage in Sylvassa. We dedicated a church building for our church in the Songarh area it was a wonderful time.

Please Pray:

We are Planning to start a Bible School in the state of Rajasthan this year, to train new Pastors and to send them out to start new churches.



Convention News

Our state convention in Andhra Pradesh was conducted during the 3rd week of January. More than 200 Pastors and Believers attended our convention. All of us dedicated ourselves to start 50 new churches in that state this year. We planned to conduct at least 30 mini crusades in different areas.

Also I decided and announced that we will start an orphanage in that country this year. This will take the number of orphanages to 11. We need \$20,000 to build our orphanage building.
