On one of his visits to the state of Madhya Pradesh, his heart was moved after seeing the pathetic condition of the little tribal children, then himself he decided to reach out to these children and give them a better life. God put in his heart to start the Bethesda Boys Home Malanjkhanda, which is one of the 17 Homes. Through his vision and passion, Dr. R. Abraham has transformed and rebuilding many lives through the love of Jesus Christ. We have many success stories to share and this is one of them.

Mahesh Rahangdale who was an orphan from Village—Sanda, Th.—Paraswada, Distt.—Balaghat was brought to our home in the year of 2003. A very dull boy studying in 4th standard Gov. School, it was a difficult task for the home parents to make him study and teach good habits. It took a long time to make him live a disciplined life. At first teachers would complain about him that he is very notorious and wrote him off saying he will not be able to learn and study. The home parents along with the Church started to pray for him, many fasted for him, and

a person from the Church started a tuition class for everyone at Bethesda home. After a few months' things started changing and Mahesh gradually changed and he started reading and learning. He learnt to live a disciplined life. He stayed with us at Bethesda home for 8yrs (2011), completed his 12th, and then his guardians took him back. His guardians could not stop him from being what God wanted him to be. He ran away to Nagpur, Maharashtra, where he started living and earning.

Now after 5 years of hard work, he is a very successful person who owns four vehicles, of which two are ambulance and other two are given on rent. Today Mahesh is successful in both his spiritual and physical life. He is God fearing and loves God. He got married to a good girl and both are having a beautiful baby boy. Mahesh is one example of successful boys of Bethesda home. Whenever he comes to his village, he visits Bethesda home and brings lots of gifts to present boys. Training and equipping is the key for the growth of New India Church of God's missions & vision. In our Bible colleges and training centres which are operating in various states of India, we raise future leaders and pastors of various states to go back and become full-time pastors. These institutes house, train and give these students the knowledge and spiritual guidance to reach out to people of their specific people groups with regard to their culture and background. We have seen great success through these programs and today hundreds of churches are pioneered by our graduates all over the nation. We currently offer 3 year Bachelors of Theology and two years Diploma of Theology programs. Majority of our students will have to learn English language first to fit into the training program. Learning this language also helps our student to understand the world better. One such story of a life transformed is of Sunny from Sikkim.

Sunny was enrolled in BBC in the year 2008. At that time he didn't know anything much about Bible and was a simple believer in his local

church. But within 3 years of his stay in BBC, the knowledge of Bible transformed his thoughts and faith completely. This is what he says, "Our teachers not only taught us but we were also inspired by their lives and commitment and it encouraged me to do something for our God."

After graduating from BBC, Sunny is ministering in Sikkim and is pastoring a church there. He also has short term Bible schools for the locals which carries the vision to impact and strengthen north-eastern churches. He also has a worship band which is invited to different places to conduct revival programmes in different states and neighbouring countries. This is what Sunny has to say. "I believe the foundation of faith and knowledge which I gained through Bethesda Bible College, really helped me to be at the position that I have Today.
